

Purpose

Our Dress Code outlines the standards expected of students and plays an important role in promoting a positive image of our school. Our Dress Code supports all students to participate fully in school life. It also helps us to create a sense of identity and a school culture in which every student experiences a sense of connection and belonging.

School Uniform

- School polo shirt with logo
- Team polo shirt with logo
- Navy shorts (mid thigh and loose fitting walk short), sports skirt, pants or skort
- School dress with logo
- School jacket with logo
- Reversible bucket hat with logo (compulsory all year round)
- Footwear – shoes, sneakers or sandals with a strap

Please ensure all clothing is clearly marked with your child's name.

Acceptable Accessories

- Hair accessories (school colours preferred)
- Small stud earrings or small sleepers, watches

Hair that is shoulder length or longer must be tied back.

Not Acceptable Items

- Denim items
- Singlets, board shorts, clothing with hoods, brand logos or graphics
- Additional decorative jewellery
- Thongs, shoes with high heels/platforms, roller shoes or slip-on shoes without a back
- Make up, fake nails or nail accessories
- Tattoos, body paint or coloured hairspray unless permitted for a special school event

Compliance

Staff will pursue a positive approach to the Dress Code, encouraging students to follow acceptable school directions. In the event that a student's presentation does not comply with the Dress Code, staff will discuss the matter with the parent (and/or student if appropriate). Repeated non-compliance will lead to a letter from the Principal and/or a meeting to discuss the matter. Non-compliance may also risk a student not participating in certain activities such as special events, excursions or student leadership opportunities.

A parent wishing to have their child exempted from complying with the dress code with a valid reason should contact the Principal.
