The Madora Bay Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2024. The schedule is broken into three sections and provides families the opportunity to calculate and plan for all costs that they may incur throughout the 2024 school year.

CONTRIBUTIONS

Financial support provided by parents plays an enabling role in the provision of resources that extend the school's capacity to add value to students' learning experiences. Money collected will be used to enhance materials, services and facilities used by our students across Kindergarten to Year Six. Whilst contributions are voluntary, teaching and learning will be maximised if all families support this initiative.

Contributions for 2024 are set at **\$60.00 per child** (Years K – 6) and can be paid via Compass, Direct Deposit, cash or included as an option through our Personal Items supplier, Campion Educational Supplies. Contributions can be paid by instalments also. Please discuss this with the Manager Corporate Services in the office.

PERSONAL ITEMS

This refers to personal items which students will require regularly throughout the school year. It is the responsibility of the classroom teacher to appropriately manage items provided for each student's personal use. This may include requesting items to be replenished during the school year and returning any unused items at the end of Term Four.

Please note, in the early years of education, children are not expected to maintain their own items and as such, items may be used flexibly and returned items may be similar to those supplied.

The charge for personal items will vary from student to student and include:

- Items for all students and used in lessons e.g. stationery items
- Items recommended but not essential for all students
- Items for selected students and not directly part of the educational program e.g. Leaver's shirt, class photographs or other pay as you order or use.

We have negotiated competitive prices for the Personal Items, but you are not obliged to use our supplier. If you do choose to use our supplier however, the school receives a rebate which can be used to purchase resources. Personal Items Lists by year group will be provided to parents during November and will also be available on our website.
